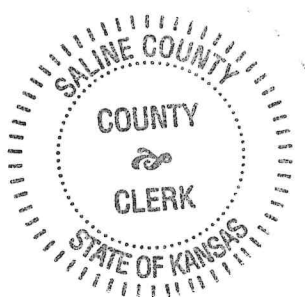
A citizen of the United States who is 18 years of age or older, or who will have attained the age of 18 at the next election must register before he or she can vote. Registration closes 21 days prior to this election.


When a voter has been registered according to law, his or her registration shall continue to be valid until one of the following occurs: (1) The voter changes name by marriage, divorce or legal proceeding; (2) The voter changes residence.

If either of the above has occurred, the voter must reregister. Application forms shall be provided by the County Election Officer upon request in person or in writing by the applicant. Such application shall be signed by the applicant under the penalty of perjury. Voters may also register to vote online at www.voteks.gov
