Snow and Ice Control Guidelines

Priorities

1st Priority: All paved roads
 2nd Priority: All gravel roads
 3rd Priority: All other roads

Activities

- 1. The County is divided into snow removal territories and the roads within each territory are assigned a priority.
- 2. Roads are cleared according to the priorities listed above, in the case of bona fide life threatening emergencies call 911.
- The County will endeavor to maintain a safe level of service for Snow and Ice Removal throughout the County. However, during heavy snow fall or blizzard conditions the County may at times cease operations until safe operating conditions prevail.
- 4. There is no plowing, unless at least two inches of snow has accumulated and snow continues to fall.
- 5. Under icing conditions, equipment may be sent out to SPOT TREAT icy sections only on paved roads.

How can I Help?

- 1. Drive safely
- 2. Don't drive if you don't have to be out
- 3. Park off roadways
- 4. Do not attempt to stop a snow removal vehicle or obstruct its path
- 5. Be patient! Snow falls unevenly throughout the County and traffic and safety problems vary considerable for one area to another
- 6. To report a snow or ice related problem, call 785-826-6525 and ask for the snow removal supervisor. If no answer, call Sheriff Office at 785-826-6500
